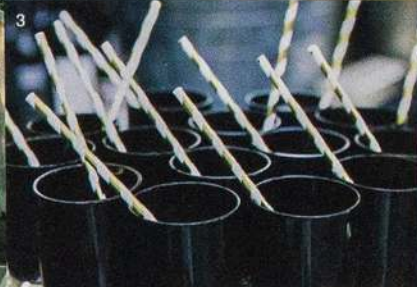

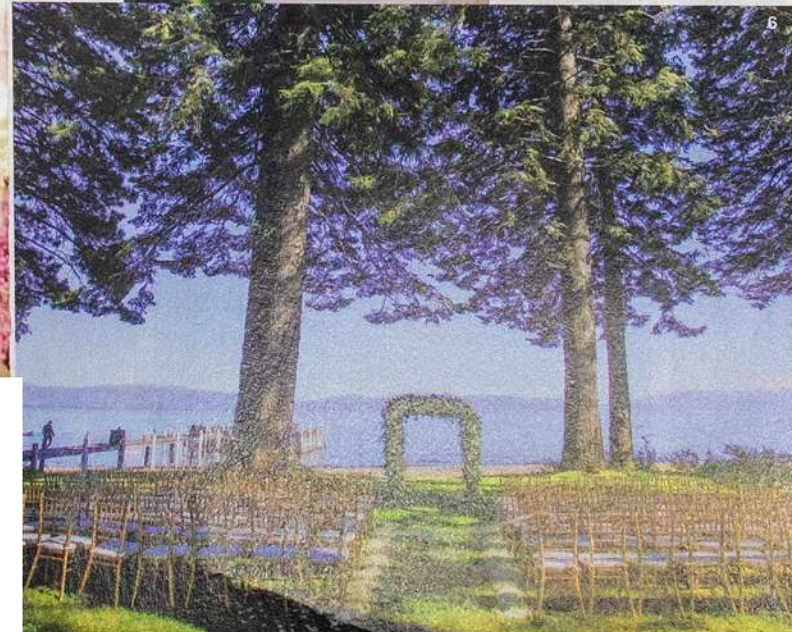

7. Leafy garlands and flowers lined tables numbered with black cardstock.

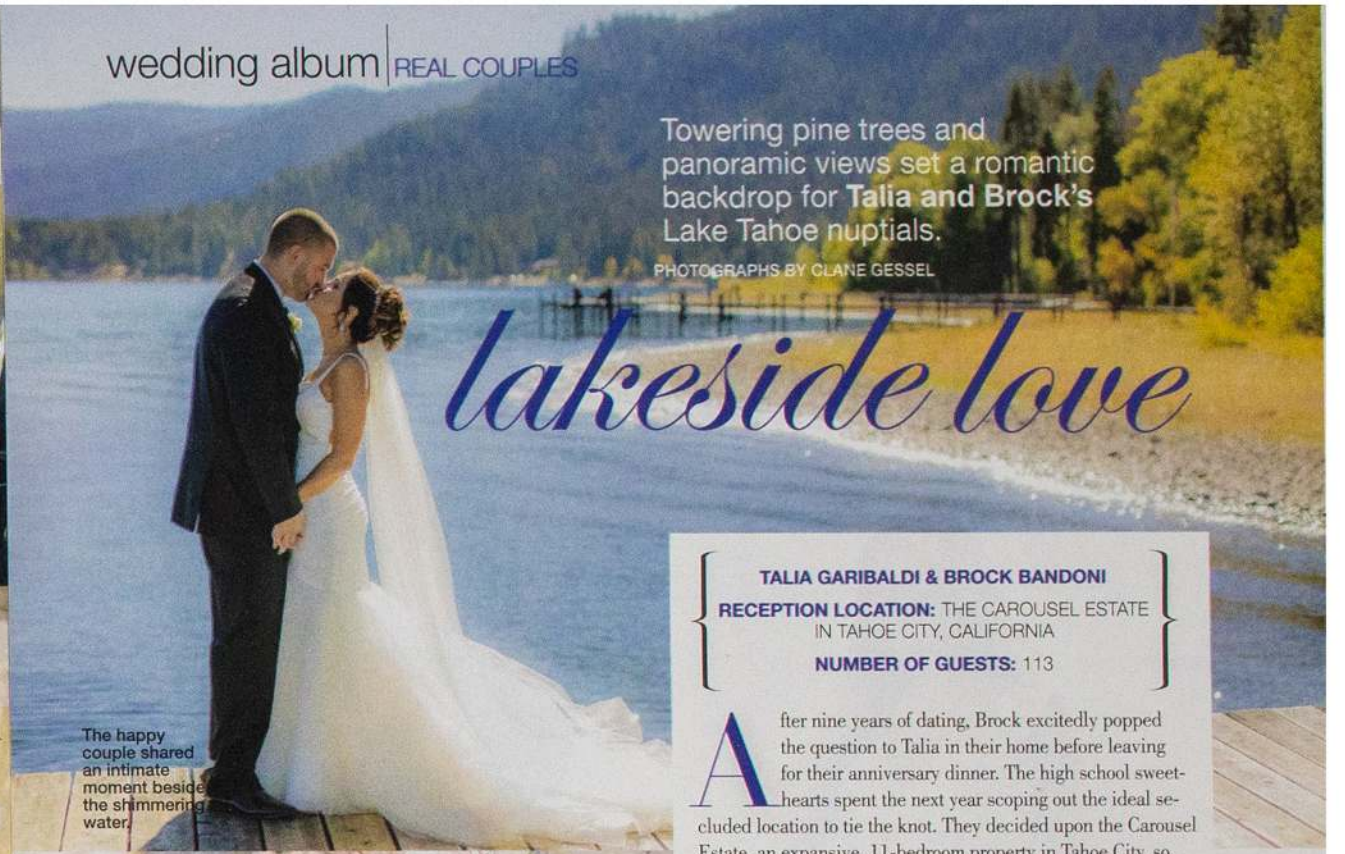
